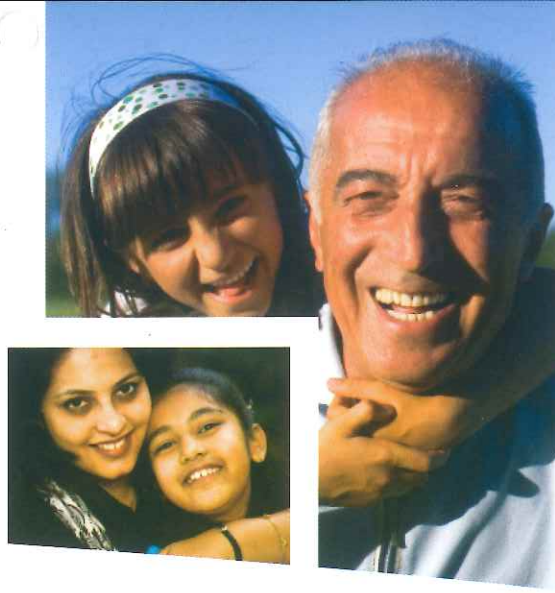

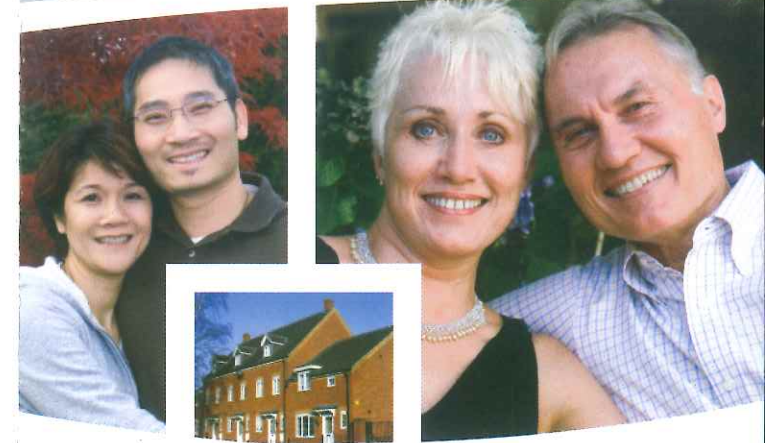

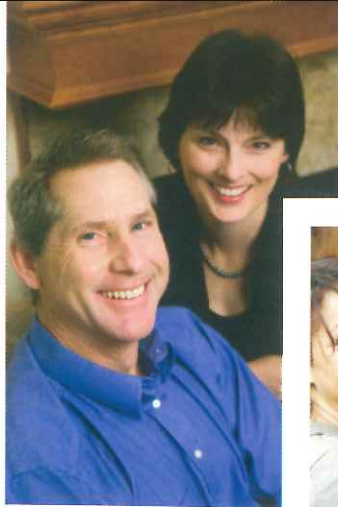

Standard Wills

A Will lets you choose who your Executors and Trustees would be. You can appoint a Guardian, a person of your choice to look after your children if you should die before they reach 16. A Will can also allow you to express your wishes as to how your estate is distributed including specific legacies to family, friends or perhaps a charity.

Protective Property Trust Wills

Under the Community Care Act of 1990 councils can force the sale of your home to recover Long Term Care cost. In recent times, 200 houses a day in the UK were taken by councils. Setting up a Protective Property Trust Will allows clients to protect their property. Furthermore this Will ensures that your share of the family home passes to your children if your partner were to later remarry.

Inheritance Tax Wills

A tax efficient Will which could dramatically reduce the tax payable on your estate.

Power of Attorney

An extremely important and cost effective document which allows you to appoint someone you trust who has the legal authority to look after your financial affairs and make care decisions on your behalf during your lifetime if you become incapacitated or at any time in your life. Incapacity can happen at any time in anyone's life through illness or an accident.

Prepaid Funeral Plans
