



**Do you or

hearing aid?**



A new community service for people who wear NHS hearing aids to collect their batteries locally is now available.

In partnership with NHS Lanarkshire and South Lanarkshire Leisure and Culture the battery collection service will be available at all South Lanarkshire Libraries including the mobile library.

You or your carer should present your hearing aid service book when collecting new batteries (as this identifies what type is required). Two packets of replacement batteries will be issued for each aid approximately every four to six months.
